



2010 Year End Budget Report

Daylight raised over \$35,000 in 2010 thanks to your support! Your gifts cover Daylight students' food, Kenyan teachers' wages, school administration costs, and school supplies. One-hundred percent of general budget expenses went to meet the needs of the children. This was possible because Michael Kimpur's missionary work was supported exclusively by designated gifts, and Daylight U.S. runs exclusively on volunteer support.

Daylight has had an incredible year! Thank you for partnering with us!

This year has brought new joys for Daylight. When Daylight opened its doors to orphans in 2008, several Kenyan families stepped forward to be foster parents to enable kids to learn at Daylight. Now so many children are coming to Daylight to find education and safety that we outgrew our facility.

We are now ministering to 150 students with five teachers and a host of volunteers! We can no longer find foster parents to meet the demand of children, so we are blessed to have been able to purchase three acres of land and are well on our way to building a dormitory to house 40 children.

Also this year, several people have stepped forward to financially support Michael Kimpur's family as a missionary to his people. The funds for his children and living stipend were designated gifts, solely for their use.
